Eurodance '98

Pete Tong, Paul Oakenfold, Dimitri from Paris and Johnny Moy (right) are among the big name DJs taking part in Eurodance '98 live on 2FM this Saturday night from 8pm to 3am on Sunday morning.

Last year's Eurodance was the world's biggest dance event with seven clubs across Europe joining together for a night of celebration, all broadcast on The European Broadcasting Union's digital satellite through twenty national radio stations to 72 million people. Micky Mac will be in Dublin's Red Box hosting the Irish leg of the night. Last year it was David Holmes who did us proud and this year rising megastar Johnny Moy of Influx steps up to the decks at The Red Box. Later, Pete Tong and Paul Oakenfold come live from Cream in Liverpool and there will also be sets from Euro heads Abstract in Oslo, Gadagong in Copenhagen, Jori Hulkkonen in Helsinki and Dimitri from Paris in uh, Paris.

"We could have sold 6,000 tickets last year," says Martin Thomas of Strictly Fish, who are promoting Eurodance '98 in The Red Box. "So this time we're telling people to get down there as early as possible to get their tickets." The event is the brainchild of BBC Radio 1 DJ Pete Tong and comes under the direction of the EBU's Eurobeat group which is chaired by 2FM's Ian Wilson who is producing the event for 2FM.
